- Phase I logging debris clean up Suggests that the best approach is to mulch and leave on property. Ms. Gall requests that Mr. Rischar provide her with Scope of Work once created.

#### • VICE CHAIRMAN & SECURITY CHAIRMAN, MR. FRYAR

 Web-site update – went live last Friday. Not fully populated, but work in progress. Very happy with results so far.

#### • SECRETARY & AVIATION CHAIR, MR. NICKELS

- FDOT Annual Airport Inspection scheduled Sept. 25<sup>th</sup> @ 12:30pm. Mr. Nickels recommends that we post this date so that multiple Board members can attend.
- In preparation of hurricane, he would like to suggest that we close off 11/29 as a staging area for any emergency vehicles and/or helicopters. Mr. Fryar stated that we should consider "X"s
- Mr. Fryar asked Ms. Gall to have Operations check all airfield drainage prior to inclement weather.

### AVIATION FACILITIES/OPS. CHAIR, MR. WYNN

Asked about a schedule to disc/harrow fire lanes around fence perimeter. Mr. Rischar suggests that we
box blade and then mow. Disc/harrowing only creates a bigger problem for access.

#### • AIRPORT MGR., MARIA GALL

- Announced that the application for the Dept. Of Economic Opportunity Infrastructure Grant continues to be modified and will be submitted by the middle part of Sept..
- Briefed the Board on the hurricane preparation:
  - 1. Hours of operation We plan to have staff available over the weekend to assist tenants with hangar preparation. Advised employees to make sure that their families and homes are cared for as well. Airport will be closed on Monday and depending on outcome, remaining week will be determined.
  - 2. Tenants have been advised of the hurricane hours/ closure via email as well as posting at tenant gate information Board.
  - 3. Staff has secured as much as possible; including vehicles, tractors, fuel truck, etc...

## • KH CITY MANAGER, SCOTT KORNEGAY

- Ground breaking for the Trail Head is still scheduled but may be cancelled by noon tomorrow.
- Mr. Kornegay will be recommending at council meeting, Sept. 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm that the City of KH declare the town as a State of Emergency. This allows for more flexibility for spending and processes.
- Hurricane Irma is projected to increase in speed (180-200mph). We are in dire emergency for preparation. Gov. has called ALL National Guard to active duty. 67 counties have been declared a State of Emergency.
- Chairman offered up anything from the airport the City may need.
